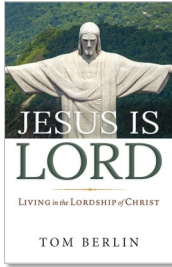
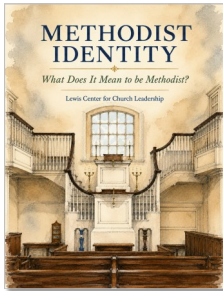

 JESUS IS LORD <i>Living in the Lordship of Christ</i> Mondays at 3:00 p.m. & 6:00 p.m. Starting September 14 Before the adoption of the ancient creeds, “Jesus is Lord” was already a foundational declaration of the early church. As Christians today, we are thankful for salvation, yet our daily lives may resemble those who do not follow Christ. The reason may well lie in one powerful profession: Jesus is Lord. To live this confession is to open the door to genuine transformation. This study explores how embracing Jesus as Lord has reshaped the lives of people in biblical times and today.

Pastor Bridget will lead an eight-session study using video presentations from United Methodist scholars, the writings of John and Charles Wesley, and group discussion to connect our history with the beliefs that distinguish us as Methodists. <i>Part 1, “Our Story,” begins in September. An additional eight-week study, Part 2, “Our Beliefs,” will begin after the new year.</i>
