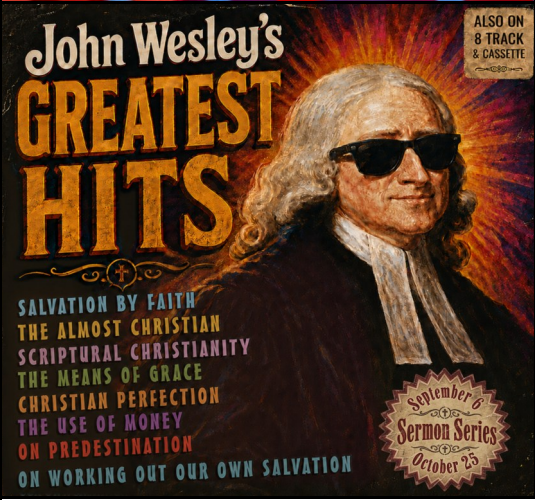
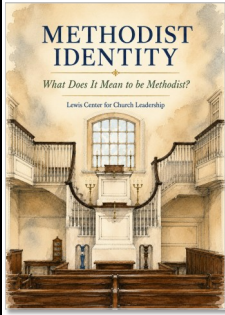

We are also responding in Sudan, where 34 million persons are in need, 19 million of whom face acute food insecurity. From our vantage point in Nebraska, we can’t possibly know all of the ways UMCOR is responding or which efforts are fully funded and which still need our support. What we do know is that every dollar we give goes directly to relief efforts because our UMCOR Sunday offering already paid for administration and an initial operating balance. 	METHODIST IDENTITY: <i>What Does It Mean to be Methodist?</i> September 8, brief introduction and material distribution, 6:30 p.m. September 15, study begins, 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Why do United Methodists believe what we believe, and where do those beliefs originate?
